


However, he believed that his greatest achievement was not any of the above but in tutoring a legally deaf classmate for over four years and seeing him receive his diploma. For this there was no award or written commendation but just the satisfaction of making a significant contribution to one in need. Excellence in academics and humanitarian acts of kindness and caring for others in need are the hallmarks of a life well lived.

Where best to perpetuate these characteristics of excellence in

academic achievement and humanitarian values than AUA which was founded on the day Armenia declared its independence and announced itself a democratic state.

Where else but in Armenia where freedom and expression of thought were repressed for seventy years.

Where else but in Armenia where there was always an extraordinary amount of talent but the absence of a truly democratic western style of education.

In Yerevan, the ancient capital of Armenia, on a hill facing Mount Ararat, the tallest mountain in the country's historic homeland, the American University of Armenia is adding a state-of-the-art academic building complex to expand its single-structure campus. building is set into a steep hillside site in a precarious seismic zone. The harsh climate, unpredictable energy grid, onerous building codes, a tight budget, and limited access to materials and skilled constructors would challenge even a simple project. University required an innovative, flexible building that would provide classrooms for students, offices for faculty and administrative staff,

and a residence for the president of the university.

Adapting the complex program to the constraints of a 10,000-square-meter building required an in-depth utilization study and a design that takes full advantage of modular solutions that allow the spaces to serve multiple purposes. To meet demand for advanced, highly flexible technology, the building is designed to accommodate the latest in video, computer, and telecommunications equipment, including wireless networking.

The design is an environmentally sensitive solution that creates alternative solutions to the university's energy needs. These include simple concepts such as setting the building orientation to minimize heat gain in the summer and maximize both heat gain and sunlight exposure in the winter; sophisticated innovations that include a breathing stone wall that adds additional insulation;

and light shelves that reflect low winter sun deep into the south-facing rooms. A second level bridge connects to the existing structure, and a public pathway through the adjacent park passes underneath the building to continue the connected pedestrian linkage to public transit.
