BACKGROUND

Research (CHSR) is an applied research center located within the Department of Public Health at the American University of Armenia (AUA). CHSR was established in 1995 to respond to the research and development needs in the multidisciplinary field of Public Health in Armenia.

The AUA's Department of Public Health is affiliated with the Johns Hopkins University School of Hygiene & Public Health, and represents an integrated effort to develop local expertise in managing health programs, assessing the health needs of the people of Armenia, and translating that knowledge into improved health by designing, implementing, and evaluating programs to meet those needs.

Currently, the Department of Public Health offers a graduate program that in the first year leads to a Certificate in Public Health and in the second year to the Master of Public Health (MPH) degree.

MISSION AND OBJECTIVES

HSR offers its expertise as a resource to support and facilitate the existing public health infrastructure.

The guiding principles of the center are to:

- Provide supervised field training for students enrolled in the AUA Public Health Program;
- Serve as a venue for linkages between the Ministry of Health, donor agencies, and the expertise of the program's faculty;
- Respond to requests for technical assistance from local Armenian ministries and research institutes;
- Support programmatic development of health services in conjunction with the Ministries of Health of the region.
