About the lecturer: Jack Maresca is currently the President of the Open Media Research Institute (OMRI) in Prague which is the succession to the Radio Free Europe / Radio Liberty Research Institute. He is also associated with the United States Institute of Peace and Search for Common Ground. During his Foreign Service career Mr. Maresca has served as United States Ambassador to the CSCE and to the negotiations on military Confidence and Security Building Measures. He was the US mediator for the conflicts in Nagorno Karabakh and Cyprus, and was sent as a Special Envoy to open US relations with the newly independent states from the former USSR and Albania.

Maresca served as Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense for European and NATO Policy in the Reagan Administration. Prior to that time he was a Visiting Fellow at Georgetown University and US Minister to France (1982-85). He also served as Director of Western European Affairs in the State Department, Deputy Political Counselor at the US Embassy in Paris, Officer-in-Charge, CSCE and NATO Political Affairs, Department of State, Deputy Head of the US Delegation to the negotiation of the CSCE's Helsinki Final Act of 1975, and Deputy Director of the Office of two NATO Secretary Generals. He is the author of the books "To Helsinki", (Duke University Press, 1985), "The End of the Cold War is Also Over", (Stanford University, 1995).
