Subject: Memorandum of 8 April 1992 from Alexander Kalorian

Mihran:

I agree with Alexander that an AUA Student Identification Card is an urgent need. My thoughts on the subject are as follows. In the short term, we should probably think in terms of a laminated card valid for one year that contains the AUA logo and name, a photograph of the student, the student's signature, and the student's I.D. number (this should be the same as the number on the student's permanent record card). In the longer term, we may want to think about a permanent plastic card with electronic coding (so as to serve as a library card, etc.) and a system of stickers to indicate current student status.

I have asked Katrina to compare the format of several (U.S.) university student I.D. cards and to prepare a recommendation for an AUA student I.D. card that could also double as a library card.

The remainder of Alexander's recommendations appear to me to be eminently reasonable.
