ABOUT THE AMERICAN UNIVERSITY OF ARMENIA

The American University of Armenia, AUA, was founded to address the long-term needs in Armenia and the region as a whole. Its mission is to educate and train a new generation of leaders in the best tradition of American Universities and Graduate Schools. With the financial and organizational support of the Armenian General Benevolent Union and the academic and institutional affiliation granted by the University of California, together with land grants, facilities and subsidies provided by the Government of Armenia, AUA has a solid foundation as it begins to fulfill its educational mission.

On September 23, 1991, the day Armenia declared independence, AUA opened its doors with 101 enrolled graduate students. Intensive courses in English and computer applications prepared the students to enter their chosen fields in Business Management, Earthquake Engineering, or Industrial Engineering. With faculty members drawn from some of the best American universities, instruction is conducted in English according to the highest standards of comparable U.S. universities.

The second academic year started on September 21, 1992, with the enrollment of 140 new students. A University Extension was also organized to offer short courses and training programs for people in the work place who cannot afford the time to become full time students. Two Research Centers, Center for Business Research and Development and the Engineering Research Center, provide Research Assistantships to students who work with faculty and local scientists on projects that contribute to the advancement of the economy and lifestyle of Armenia and the surrounding region. A Center for Environmental Management and Science, affiliated with the Engineering Research Center, provides environmental sensitivity and awareness programs to the students in the regular and extension programs.

AUA plans to establish degree programs in Public Policy and Political Science, Public Health and Health Care Management, and Agricultural Sciences. A new campus is being planned on land located on a hill in the suburbs of Yerevan.

Learn the English language. It is an important language for Armenia as it enters the international family of nations, but do not forget your mother tongue. Do not study to please your teacher or to receive a diploma, but to advance yourselves in order to be true to your mission of helping Armenia.
