***RE: The East & Central Europe Journal Donation Project***

Dear Dr. Gibson,

I am writing to you at the behest of Jonathan F. Fanton, President of the New School for Social Research, to invite your library to become a recipient of donated journals through the New School's *East & Central Europe Journal Donation Project*. Let me tell you something about this Project: it was designed to help rebuild the research base of libraries in East & Central Europe, the Baltic Republics and the Former Soviet Union. To this end, we have been soliciting donations of subscriptions to current scholarly journals as well as substantial runs of back volumes to scholarly journals in the social sciences, the humanities, the arts, law, medicine, and the sciences. I have enclosed a brochure which will provide you with further information.

At this time, we would like to invite the library of your university to become a recipient of journals donated through this project. The criteria for participation in this project are as follows:

1. We request that you provide us with the name of someone, if it is not to be yourself, who is willing to be in regular contact with us, so that we can establish a working relationship with the library. We ask that this librarian agree to be in regular contact with us, informing us of the receipt/nonreceipt of journals and of how the journals will be made available to the user population. We would also like the librarian to request journals from us which are desired by the university's faculty for teaching and research purposes, so that we might solicit journals of particular interest to the scholarly community.
2. We request that you provide us with a comprehensive list of your foreign journal holdings. To honor your requests for journals, we must have this information on file.
3. We request that you provide us with telephone and FAX numbers and an e-mail address, if possible.

4. We request that you send us periodic reports in which you describe where the journals are housed, how they are catalogued and made available. We would also like you to describe for us the degree to which the journals are used, whether they are highly reproduced through xeroxing, and whether they are used strictly within the library or whether they are given out on loan.


5. We request that you provide us with information about those who will be using your library. One of our aims is to place journals where they will be accessible to as many users as possible. Demand for journals far exceeds supply; hence, we must place journals in the most central locales.

So as to provide us with all the requested information, please answer the enclosed questionnaire.

Along with the questionnaire, I am also sending a list of the journals which we currently have available, accompanied by a set of descriptions which we hope will help you in making your selections. As subscriptions to these titles are to begin in January 1994, it is very important that we hear back from you by early October. PLEASE return your list of selected titles to us by either FAX or air mail. Our FAX number is 212-229-5476.

Please know that I look forward to hearing from you and to working with you.
